### Getting to the Workshop ('A' on the map)

**BY RAIL:** Take Chiltern Railways line to **Haddenham and Thame Parkway** station from Bicester, Banbury, Oxford and the Midlands, and from London (Marylebone) via High Wycombe (through service), or to **Aylesbury** via Amersham and then Arriva Bus route 280 as below.

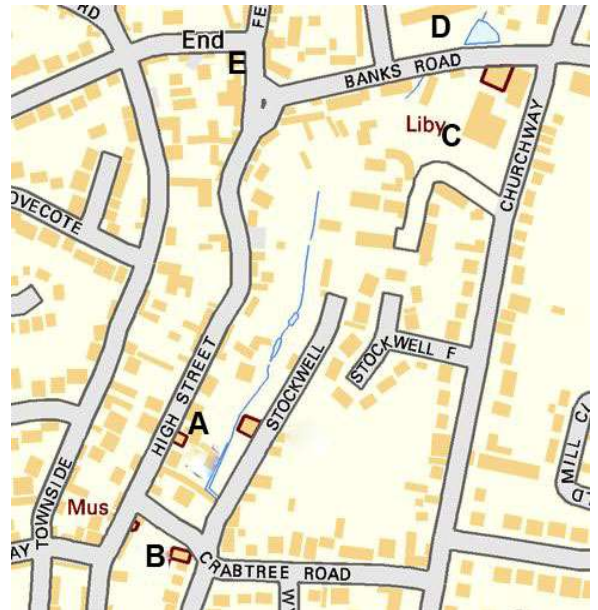
From the station by foot (15 min), turn left towards the village centre and **Fort End (E)**, or from the station forecourt take the 280 bus towards Aylesbury (every 20 min), and alight at the Fort End stop.

**BY BUS:** Take Arriva Bus route 280 (every 20 min) from Aylesbury Bus Station, or from Oxford Rail Station via Headington, Thame and Haddenham and Thame Parkway station, alighting at the **Fort End (E)** stop, then follow the walking route below.

**WALKING ROUTE from Fort End (E):** At the triangular green opposite the *House of Spice Indian Restaurant* follow the **High Street**. The **Methodist Church (A)** is after about 250 metres on the left.

**PARKING** in the High Street is currently very restricted. However, you can use the parking spaces at the **Church of the Good Shepherd (B)** (please vacate by 4.30 pm) and there are additional spaces behind the **Village Hall (C)**, in **Banks Road Parade (D)** and on-street.

When parking on-street, please use consideration for residents and road users: some of the roads in Haddenham are very narrow.
